WHEREAS, the programs that increase and promote diversity in higher education, help foster a more well-rounded campus environment; and,

WHEREAS, the negative impact on Colorado's workforce will hinder economic growth by decreasing human capital; and,

WHEREAS, the Student Representative Council wishes to recognize and represent these students to the local and state government since fear of deportation and/or criminal charges prevents these students from representing themselves.

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Student Representative Council is committed to supporting the Higher Education Access Alliance in its efforts to find a bi-partisan solution to provide higher education opportunities for all of Colorado's students, regardless of immigration or economic status.
