   and other upgrades.





## Performing Arts Academic Building


- New 80,000 GSF Performing Arts Academic Building, with proximity to Campus Commons performance hall.

- Art & Design remains on Central Campus.




## Performing Arts Academic Building & Quad








## **New Indoor Practice Facility & Locker Rooms**


 10,000 GSF locker room, storage, and supporting facilities adjacent to Nottingham Field
