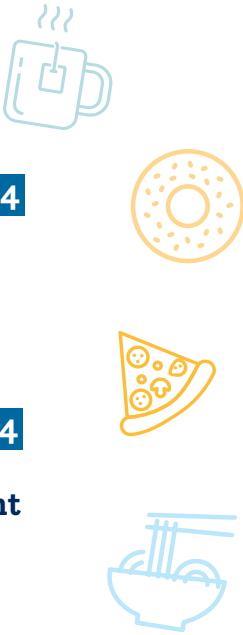

Relocating during your visit:

When parking in a different lot, you’ll need to **update your Passport App to the new zone number**. These are labeled on the map and on signage in the lots.

Other Visitors:

UNC short-term parking is available through the **Passport App**. Each lot has a unique zone number, which you can find on Passport signs located at lot entrances and throughout the lots. Zone numbers are also labeled on the map. To park, just download the app, enter the zone you are parked in along with your license plate, and pay via credit card.
