



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Colorado Application for State Financial Aid







ELIGIBLE TO APPLY: COLORADO ASSET STUDENTS

Attended a Colorado high school for one year immediately before graduation and has been physically present in Colorado for 12 consecutive months prior to enrolling in an institution

HOW TO APPLY

FAFSA & CASFA ON THE WEB

STUDENTS SHOULD ONLY COMPLETE ONE APPLICATION



WHERE:

STUDENTAID.GOV HIGHERED.COLORADO.GOV/CASFA



WHEN:

OCTOBER 1 THE YEAR BEFORE *SUBJECT TO CHANGE FOR 2024-25



HOW:

CREATE AN FSA ID OR ACCOUNT (FOR STUDENT AND PARENT FOR FAFSA)



PRIORITY DEADLINE:

MARCH 1



The FAFSA or CASFA needs to be renewed every year!

How to apply

UNC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

OVER 700 DIFFERENT SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE



Opens: November 1



February 1 for incoming freshmen and continuing students

June 1 for transfer and graduate students



Accepted students can access the UNC Scholarship Application through their URSA Account



If selected, students must complete a **Gratitude Survey** in order to receive the Scholarship funds

FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

Enrollment REQUIREMENTS



All courses must be required for degree program/graduation to count toward enrollment for financial aid purposes



Students can have minors added to their **graduation requirements** for additional coursework to be considered for financial aid enrollment*

* Must be done prior to Major degree requirements being met

FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

PROGRAMS & COURSEWORK

WHAT'S NOT ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL AID:

- Standalone certificate, endorsement, or licensure programs (except for teacher licensure)
- Non-degree status (seeking/exploring status for second BAs)
- A minor added *after* degree requirements are fulfilled
- Prerequisite or remedial courses
- Courses taken outside of classification, e.g. graduate student taking undergraduate courses*

MAINTAINING AID

FACTORS AFFECTING AID

WHAT ADVERSELY AFFECTS FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY?

- Missing deadlines
- Failure to submit required documentation and/or requirements
- Student non-attendance, withdrawals, and dropped module courses
- Academic decisions: ie. taking unnecessary coursework resulting in reaching loan and grant limits
- 6 Academic performance



MAINTAINING AID

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)

WHAT IS IT?

Students must be meeting SAP to continue receiving financial aid funding

- Maintain a minimum 2.0 **cumulative** GPA for UG & 3.0 GPA for GR
- Complete 67% of attempted overall credits
- Achieve degree prior to reaching 150% of the credit hours required to complete program
- Cannot be academically suspended from the University
- In one semester, cannot drop below 1.0 GPA (2.0 for GR) or have 0% completion

SAP STANDINGS:

- WARNING semester if below 2.0 GPA for UG or 3.0 for GR and/or 67% completion rate
- **INELIGIBLE** if requirements are not met for two consecutive terms
- INELIGIBLE MAX if student exceeds 150% of the credits hours required for program
- INELIGIBLE if UG cumulative GPA drops below a 1.0 in a single term (2.0 for GR) or there is 0% completion
- Students can submit an appeal to the financial aid office to have their eligibility reconsidered

SAP APPEAL

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)

PROCESS FOR STUDENTS:

- Upon grades posting, SAP runs and students receive an INELIGIBLE requirement on their URSA
- Access SAP Appeal through URSA by selecting INELIGIBLE requirement
- Complete Personal Statement
 Should outline what occurred specifically during semester causing SAP issue, what has changed, and what will be done for improvement (what is their plan)*
- Provide supporting documentation for what occurred

Spring 2023 SAP Appeal Deadline: April 8, 2022

 ${}^*Can't\ complete\ multiple\ appeals\ for\ same\ circumstance$

SAP APPEAL

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP)


ADVISOR ROLE:

Assist with supporting documentation (as appropriate)

Academic Plan signed by advisor outlining remaining courses needed in the student's program

*only needed for maximum hours appeals

Proof of routine check-in with advisor (as possibly outlined in improvement plan)

Financial Aid will not disburse if there are incomplete requirements!

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENT

FAFSA (and CASFA) utilize income information for families from 2 years back to determine **Financial Need** through establishment of an **EFC** (**Expected Family Contribution**)

The **EFC** is then utilized to determine the eligibility for need-based aid


Students & families who may have suffered significant income loss in more recent years may be eligible to have their more current income taken into consideration

If you encounter a student/family who discloses this may be their situation, please connect them with us to initiate this conversation and discuss options!


