Fall 2024 Highlights



1.5% Increase

New First-Time (NFT)
Students

44% First Generation

39% URM

28% Hispanic/Latiné



26.9% HSI Highest overall enrollment of Hispanic/Latine students compared to the previous 5 years and an increase of .6% from last year point-in-time.

85.4% Fall to Fall Persistence Rate – highest since Fall 2009 for all undergraduate degree-seeking students.

75.9% RECORD Highest fall-to-fall retention for NFT

25% Increase Pell eligible undergraduate degree-seeking from fall 23 to fall 24 due to FAFSA simplification process.

7.2% NEW graduate degree-seeking students

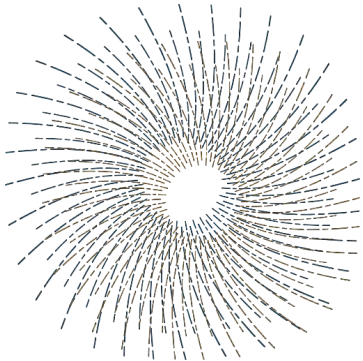

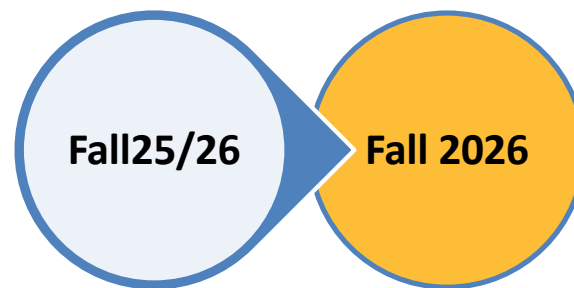
