

DISC GOLF COURSE

DISC GOLF

Disc golf is played like ball golf, but you are using a disc golf disc. One stroke is counted each time the disc is thrown and when a penalty is incurred, such as out of bounds. The object is to acquire the lowest possible score.

RULES

- 1. Tee off from the designated tee area.
- 2. After the initial throw, the player with a disc farthest from the hole throws first. Subsequent shots will be thrown from where the disc came to rest. A player will throw as many times as needed to get the disc inside the basket.
- 3. A run-up and normal follow-through after release is allowed more than 10 meters from the basket. Within the 10 meters, a player may not step past the point of the lie until after the disc thrown has landed.
- 4. Each hole is finished when the disc comes to rest inside the basket. The player who has completed all holes at the lowest total score is the winner.

REMEMBER

- 1. Do not throw when people are on or near the fairway. Pedestrians have the right of way.
- 2. Shout "Fore" on any errant throws.
- 3. Only throw if you have a visual on your intended flight path and it is clear. Do not throw if you cannot see around a tree, building or other obstacle.
