

School of Art and Design In-Person Portfolio Review

What should I expect and what do I bring with me?

- Bring 5 to 10 physical artworks to be reviewed.
 - We will have 6-foot tables set up for you to display your work.
 - Bring display-ready work this could be a cleanly cut mat, mounted on foam core, or other means. Works do not have to be framed – just professionally presented.
 - You can bring table or floor easels or other supports to display your work if you wish, but it is not required or necessary.
 - In some cases, progress pictures or research sketchbooks of process are helpful, but not required.
- You can also bring a computer or tablet to show digital, video, or animated work.
- Be ready to talk briefly about your work. Highlight any themes or ideas you are exploring. How does your work reflect you as an artist? Are there any questions you have or things you would like to hear from us? How can we help you advance your goals?

Upon arrival, artists can set work up on the tables provided in the Campus Commons Gallery. A short welcome session starts at 9:00 in the performance hall. Once that is finished, we recommend attending session one about financial aid. During this time the faculty will be reviewing student artwork. After session one, students will meet with faculty to discuss their work back in the gallery. After those conversations, a tour of the School of Art and Design will be offered. Wear comfortable walking shoes.

- You do NOT have to submit a digital portfolio to attend portfolio review days. You do not have to attend portfolio review days to submit a digital portfolio scholarship application.
- Scholarship funding awarded will be held until April 15 before the start of the fall semester. If a student does not commit to UNC by that date, any awarded funds may be removed.
