I would like to request access to utilize the free services of 240 Tutoring to prepare to take my content required Praxis exam(s). I understand that my access to the service will initially be for 30 days, which begins the day my access is provided. If my program requires more than 1 test, I will be eligible for additional access, which should be requested when the first 30 days expires and is dependent on my showing consistent use of the service in my first 30 days. As I am required to show consistent use of the service, it is strongly encouraged that I only work on one test area at a time, if my program requires multiple tests.

- To get reactivated, you will need to show proof of registration for the actual test
- After a second Deactivation – no additional access will be provided
