What does *Water Resiliency* mean for UNC?

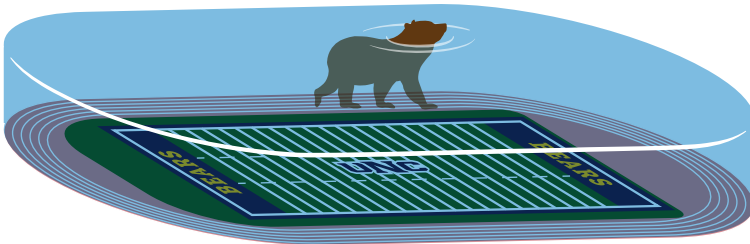
Our campus is **260 acres**
Including over **90 acres**
of small lawns!

One acre of bluegrass may
need up to **40,000 gallons**
of water per week, or
approximately **880,000
gallons** a year...

That amounts to
79,200,000 gallons!
That's enough to cover
nottingham field in nearly

**81 FEET
OF WATER**

As 40% of UNC's water comes from
the stressed Colorado River, water
resiliency means planning smarter,
using less, and creating a sustainable
campus for everyone.
