

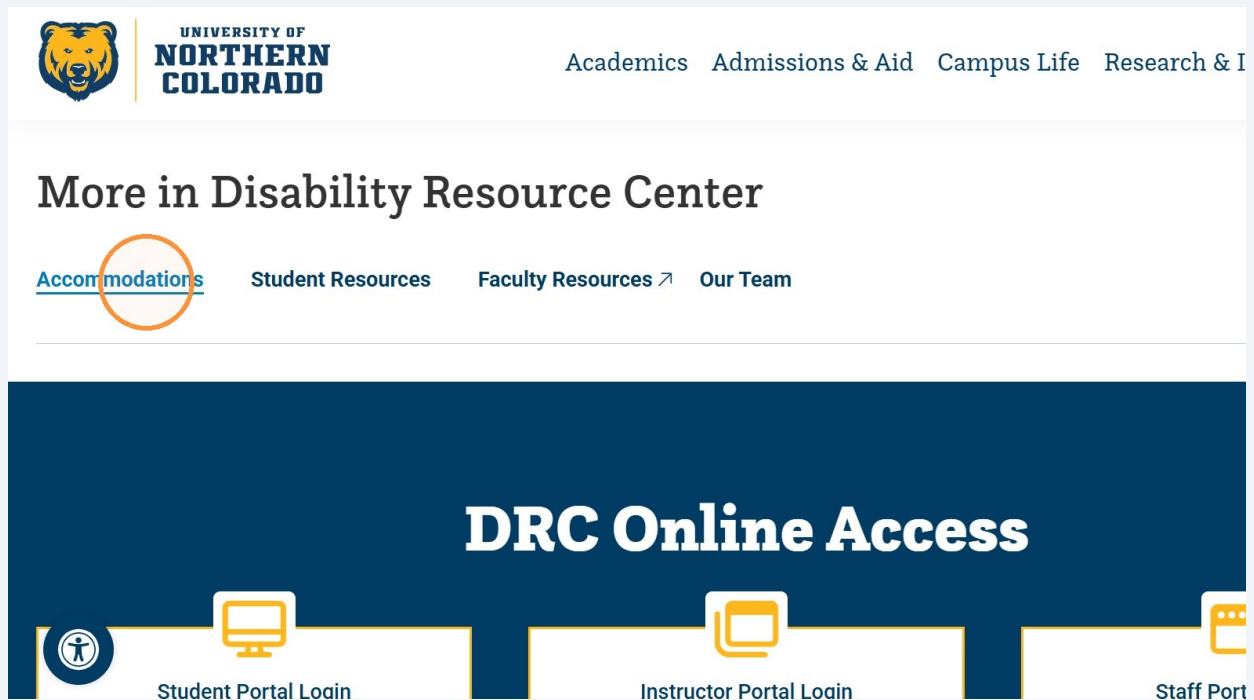

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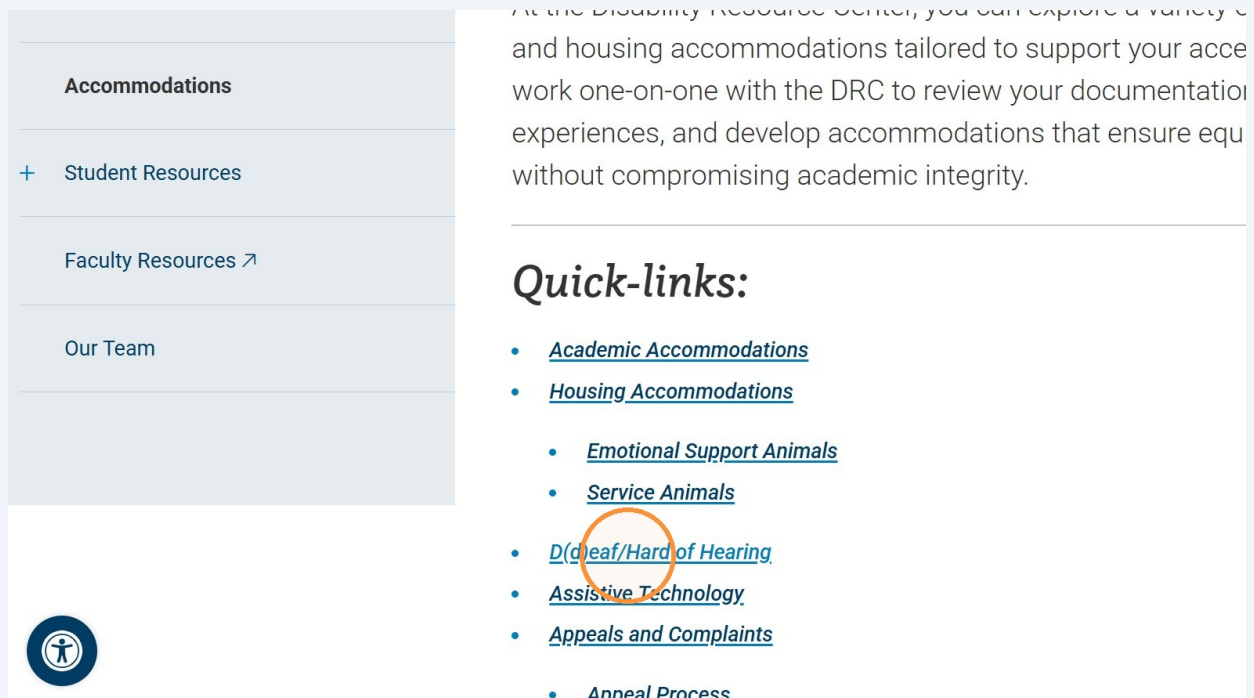

Requests for communication access can be made for any UNC-sponsored event, course, or activity. This includes—but is not limited to—theater performances, student organization events, and meetings with faculty or staff.

To request communication access, please complete the [Service Request Form](#). We encourage you to submit requests at least three days in advance. While last-minute requests are not guaranteed, we will make every effort to fulfill them. Please note that requests reviewed during university closures, including holidays and breaks.

Important Notes:

For events hosted at UNC by **outside organizations**, the event sponsor is responsible for providing communication access.



Off-campus events, access services are typically arranged by the sponsoring organization.

The DRC does not coordinate interpreting or captioning for **purely social events** that are not university-sponsored.
