2015-2016 Graduate Alumni Survey Report

The 2015-2016 Graduate Alumni Survey was conducted from May through June 2017 by the Office of Assessment at the University of Northern Colorado. A sample of 816 graduate alumni who graduated in Summer 2015, Fall 2015, and Spring 2016 was asked to provide information about their employment status and pursuit of further graduate-level education. Of these 816 alumni, 354 responded to the survey for a 43.3% response rate.
