The University of Northern Colorado awards credit for the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) General and Subject Examinations to students at or above the required score. The scores are listed on the following pages. A maximum of 30 credit hours can be applied toward the graduation requirement.

Time: All exams are 90 minutes in length

- **\$25.00 registration fee per exam**, payable to **Career Services**. Registration fee payment is due the day you schedule your exam. There is a \$25.00 rescheduling fee.
