

Fall 2019 Internship UNC Orientation Program Evaluation



New Student Orientation

One student will be needed for the fall 2019 semester to help perform an evaluation of the UNC undergraduate orientation program. Analysis will include: describing the orientation experience for freshmen, transfers, and parents; manipulating the results of the 2019 summer orientation survey for various audiences; evaluating success of learning outcomes during orientation; assessing the current survey instrument; and general evaluation of the orientation.

The ideal candidate will have experience with basic descriptive and inferential statistics, familiarity with survey construction and evaluation, will understand how to do qualitative thematic analysis, and have an ability to explain results to a non-statistical audience.

This paid internship can be counted for up to 3 credit hours for fall 2017, includes a \$1000 stipend, and will be conducted on-campus. There will be a workstation available for the intern in the Campus Commons Orientation office, and a possibility of continued work beyond the fall 2019 semester.
