**M.A. Suggested Course Sequence  
Part-Time Enrollment**

**39 credit hours, 30 required and 9 elective**

**Suggested course sequence to finish the program in 3 years (Part Time = 6 credits/semester). Required courses are offered on an annual basis, elective courses rotate based on faculty availability**

\*If required courses are full, students may instead take SRM 600: Introduction to Graduate Research, or HESA Elective and register for the required course in the second year.

**Spring 2<sup>nd</sup> year**

HESA 611 Organization and Administration (Required)  
HESA Elective

**Fall 3<sup>rd</sup> year**

HESA 683 Finance and Resource Management in Higher Education (Required)  
HESA 670 Field Experience in Student Affairs (Required) [can be taken during any summer]

**Spring 3<sup>rd</sup> year**

HESA 680 Law and Higher Education (Required)  
HESA Elective
