



## Introducing CETL Flipped!

### What Is CETL Flipped?

CETL Flipped is a new way to do professional development that provides flexibility, engagement with peers, and more time to think about your own practice.

### How Does It Work?

In CETL flipped you will watch a pre-recorded video on the topic prior to the live meeting. You will also fill out a survey before the live session indicating the topics you'd like to discuss more with peers. During the live meeting you won't sit passively listening but engage in discussion and activities that will help you start to put ideas into practice.

### What Is My Time Commitment?

The pre-assigned recording is no more than 30 minutes. You can watch that recording at your own pace until the live discussion. You will receive a pre-survey to note topics you'd like to discuss in the live session; this will take 5 minutes. The live session is 30 minutes.

### What Will I Learn?

There will be different topics offered each month starting in August 2020. We are kicking off CETL Flipped with two sessions about online teaching on August 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>.
