COUNCILOR NOMINATION FORM

Thank you for considering to serve and represent the Classified Employees at the University of Northern Colorado! Service on the Council offers the opportunity not only to represent the Classified Employees, but also to "step out" of your daily role on campus and try something new, as many leadership opportunities exist within the Council that you might not have access to in your "regular" job!

A "Council Year" is that time from July through the following June. Each term consists of two Council Years. The Council is limited to 25 members, 4 of whom are elected by each Council to serve one-year Executive positions. Councilors should typically expect Council business to take less than two (2) hours per week, including a *monthly* 90-minute General Council meeting and subcommittee meetings as needed.

Nomination Rules (Short List - for the big list, please refer to the CSC Bylaws):

- Nominations for service on the Classified Staff Council may be made by any permanent Classified Employee (including current Council members).
- All nominations shall be signed by two (2) or more Classified Employees. Self-nominations may be submitted, but shall be signed by one (1) other Classified Employee.
- Nominations may be submitted at any time!
- The Nominee shall indicate willingness to serve and acceptance of this nomination by signing this nomination form. If self-nominating, yes, please sign the form twice.
- By endorsing this nomination form, the Nominee's supervisor a.) supports the Nominee's willingness to serve, and b.) acknowledges and understands the small, but necessary time commitment for Council service.
- Incoming Council members shall be:
 - Appointed by the existing Council (including interim appointments), if there are fewer nominees than vacancies; or
 - Elected, subject to a vote of the Classified Staff, if there are fewer vacancies than nominees.
- Elections are held annually (if warranted)
