## **RSO Funding Guide**

This guide presents an overview of possible avenues for RSOs to get funding for their group. Please read each section carefully to determine if it is appropriate for your group's needs. Many of the funding options outlined in this guide are provided through outside organizations and may change without notice. The Office of Student Organizations can help your group apply for funding, but we cannot guarantee that funding will be awarded.

### **Funding opportunities at UNC**

The Office of Student Organizations offers funding to chartered RSOs seeking to host events that benefit UNC students and/or the UNC community. This funding is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. RSOs may be awarded up to \$1000 of funding per funding cycle and up to \$5,000 annually. RSOs may request up to an additional \$500 per funding cycle if they are able to match the amount requested through co-sponsorship or use of their RSO funds. To qualify for this funding, the event must be open to all UNC students, be non-profit in nature, and have demonstrable value to UNC students and/or the UNC community. The Office of Undergraduate Research offers stipends and grants to support undergraduate students engaging in research and creative endeavors. UNC undergraduate students may apply for assistance for research supplies, travel, conference presentations/performances, or as support for research and creative endeavors. Faculty, staff, graduate students are not eligible to apply. Stipends will be awarded in amounts up to \$1000 per student, per semester. While there is no guarantee of a full stipend, the Office of Undergraduate Research will fund as many eligible requests as possible. Student Senate offers funding for undergraduate students to attend academic conferences. Undergraduate students may apply for up to \$550 per semester and up to \$900 annually to attend conferences. Conference funding may be used for registration, travel, and lodging expenses. Applications for Student Senate conference funding open each year in the Fall and Spring semesters. The Graduate Student Association is an organization that advances the interests of UNC graduate students by providing grants and general support. These grants are supplemental in nature to aid in the academic and professional development of UNC's graduate students. Due to the limited nature of grant funding, each application cycle is highly competitive and designed to expose graduate students to the scrutiny and subjectivity of grants in the public and private sectors. Grants of up to \$600 can be awarded for research, to present at conferences, and to attend conferences. Student may not receive more than two grants from the Graduate Student Association per year.
