Imagination, Inspiration, Influence, and Impact



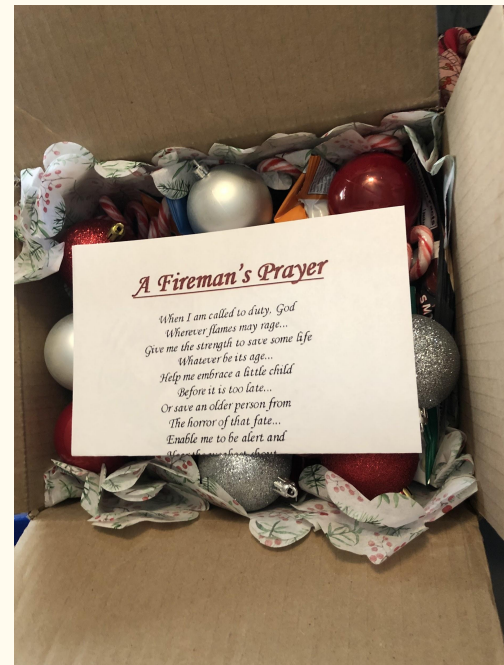
- **Imagination**- what we wanted to send for food, decorations, and how we wanted to split up the items in each package. What did we want to say in our cards?

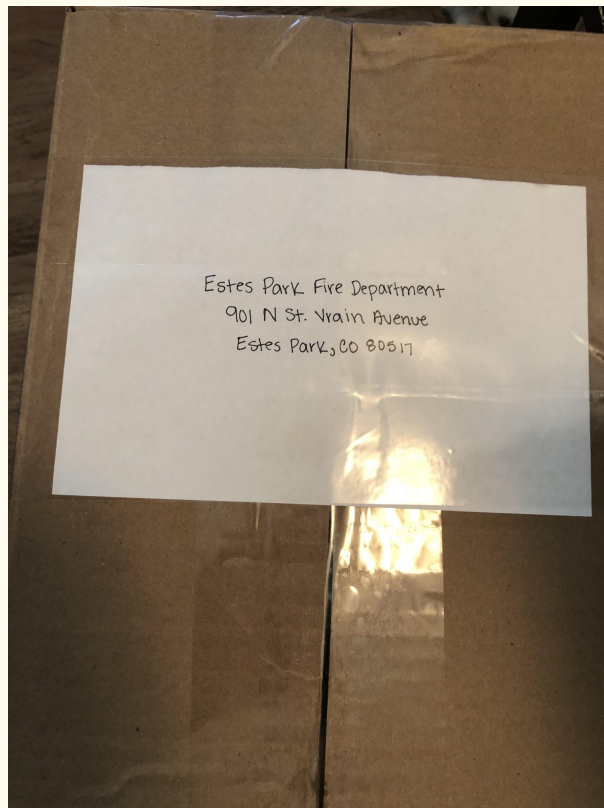
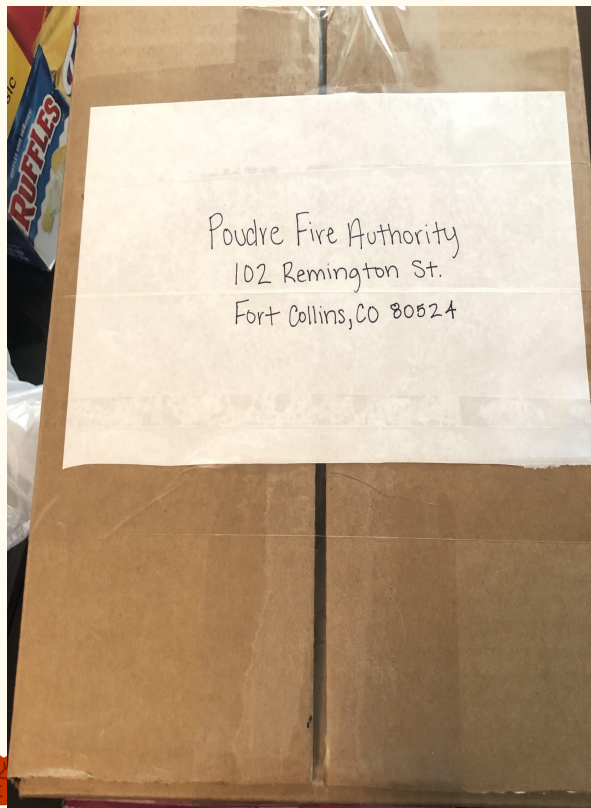
