

Alumni Survey

During the 2012-2013 academic year, 90 participants responded to the alumni survey. Among the 21-item survey, the three highest rated items are “5. My teacher education program prepared me to develop lesson plans” (M = 3.44), “15. My teacher education program prepared me to be a reflective educator” (M = 3.37), and “20. My supervised student internship/teaching prepared me to assume the role of a classroom teacher” (M = 3.37) while the three lowest rated items are “13. My teacher education program prepared me to work with parents and/or families (M = 2.63), “2. My teacher education program prepared me for teaching English Language Learners (M = 2.69), and “8. My teacher education program prepared me to address student behavior in my classroom (M = 2.69).

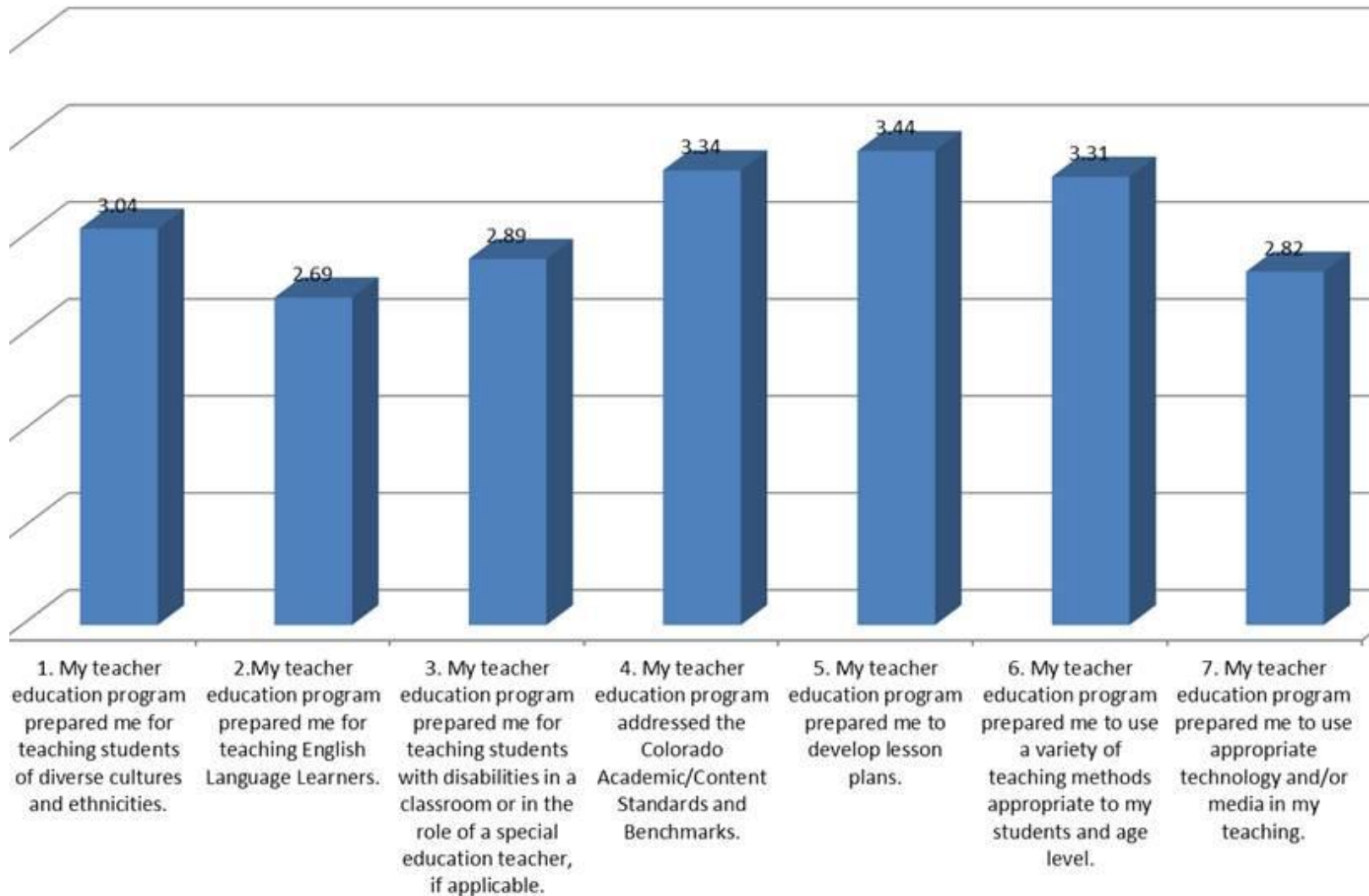

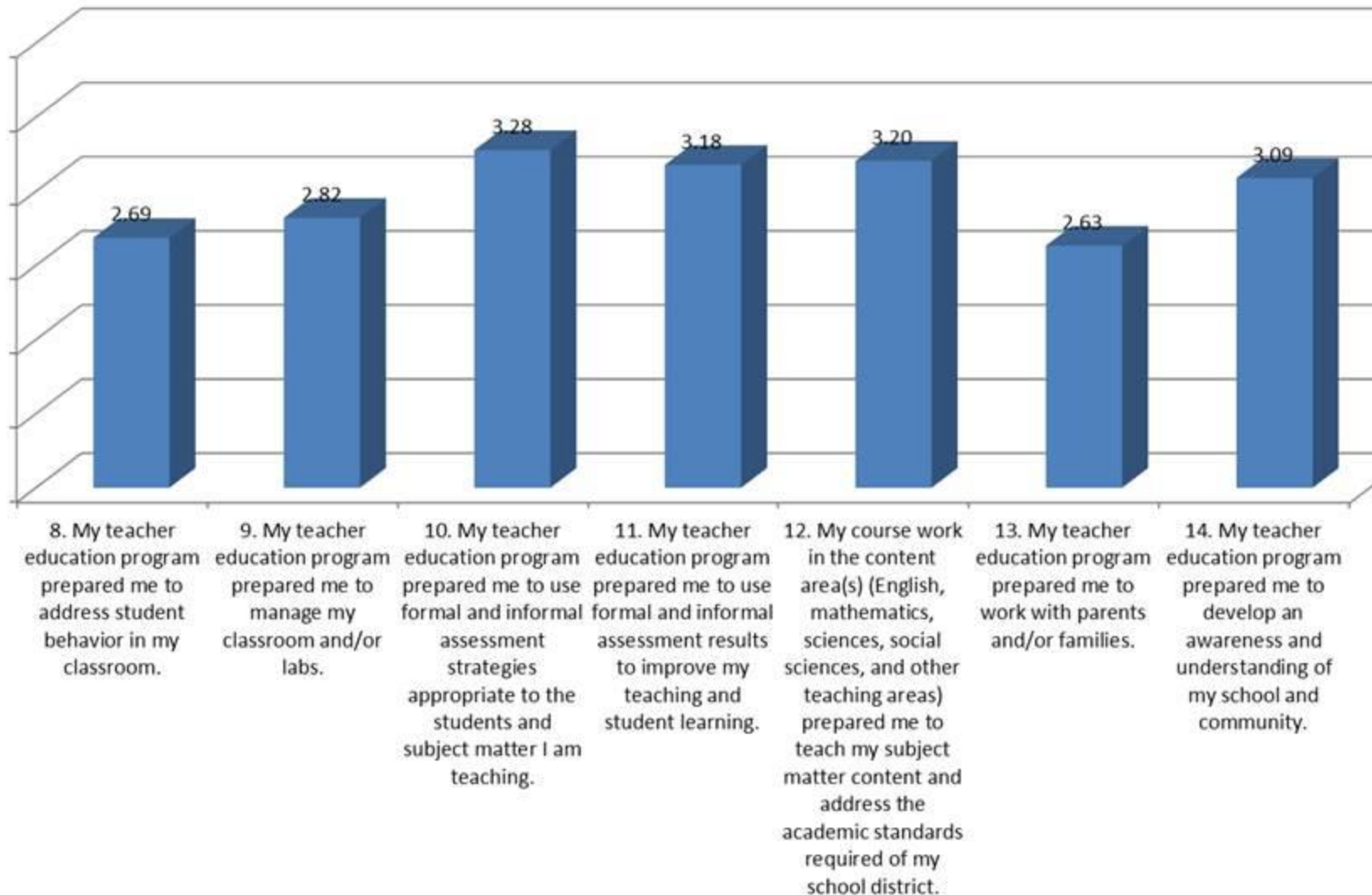

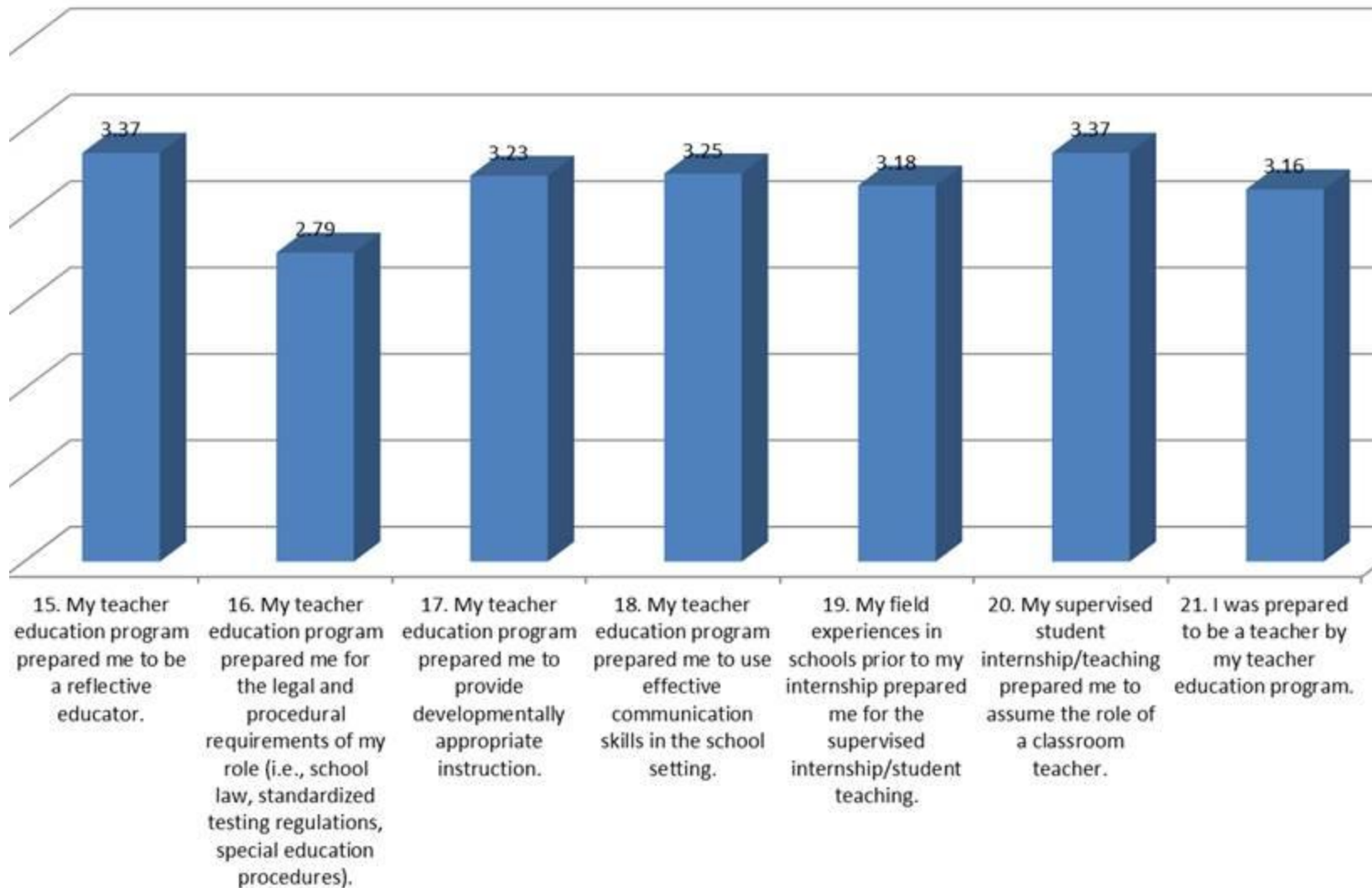

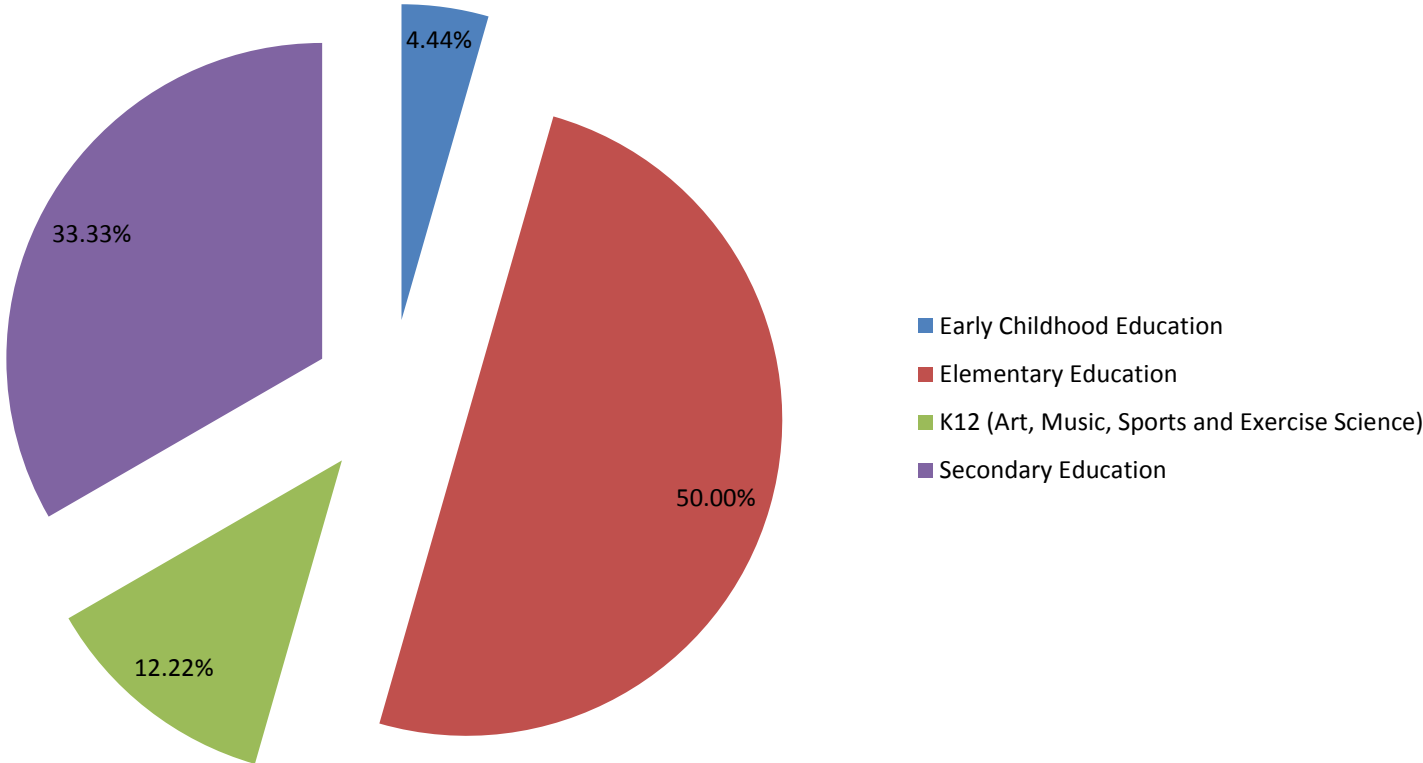

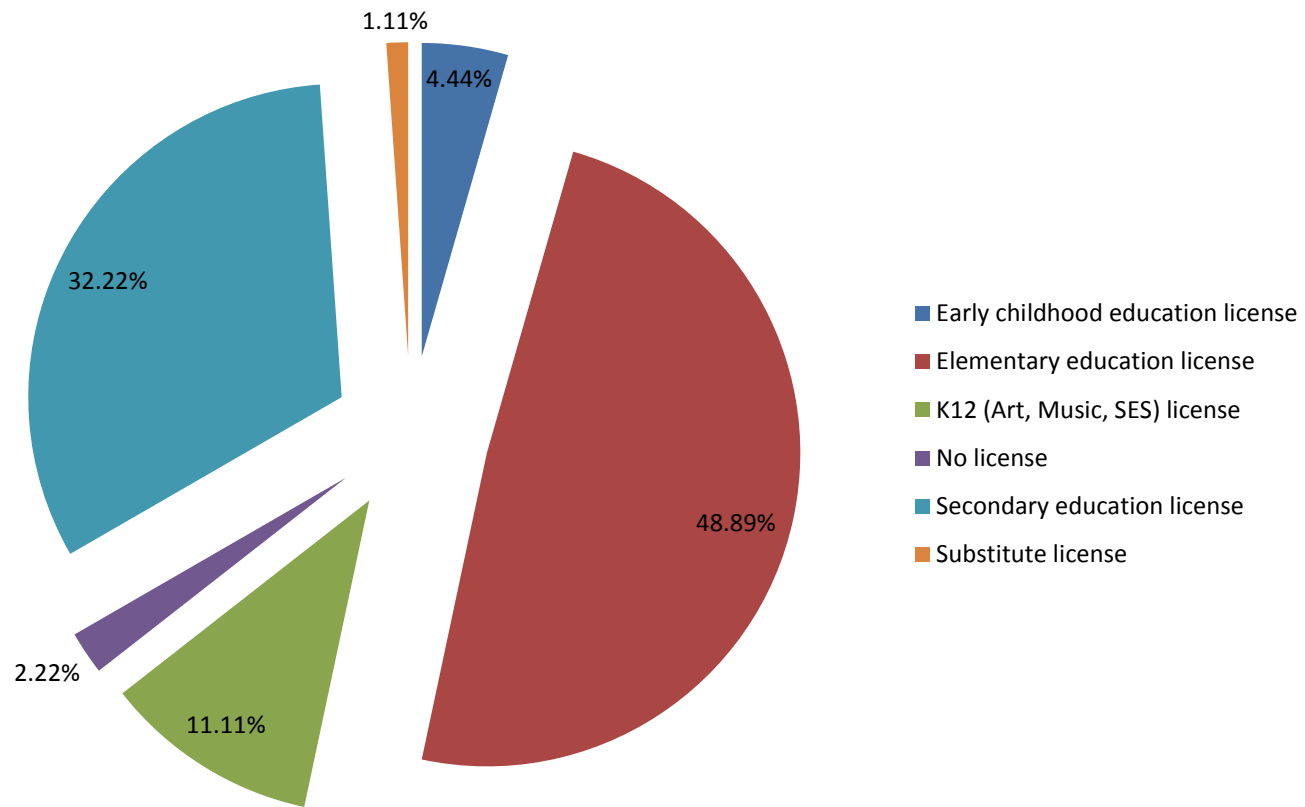

My teacher education program prepared me for licensure in:



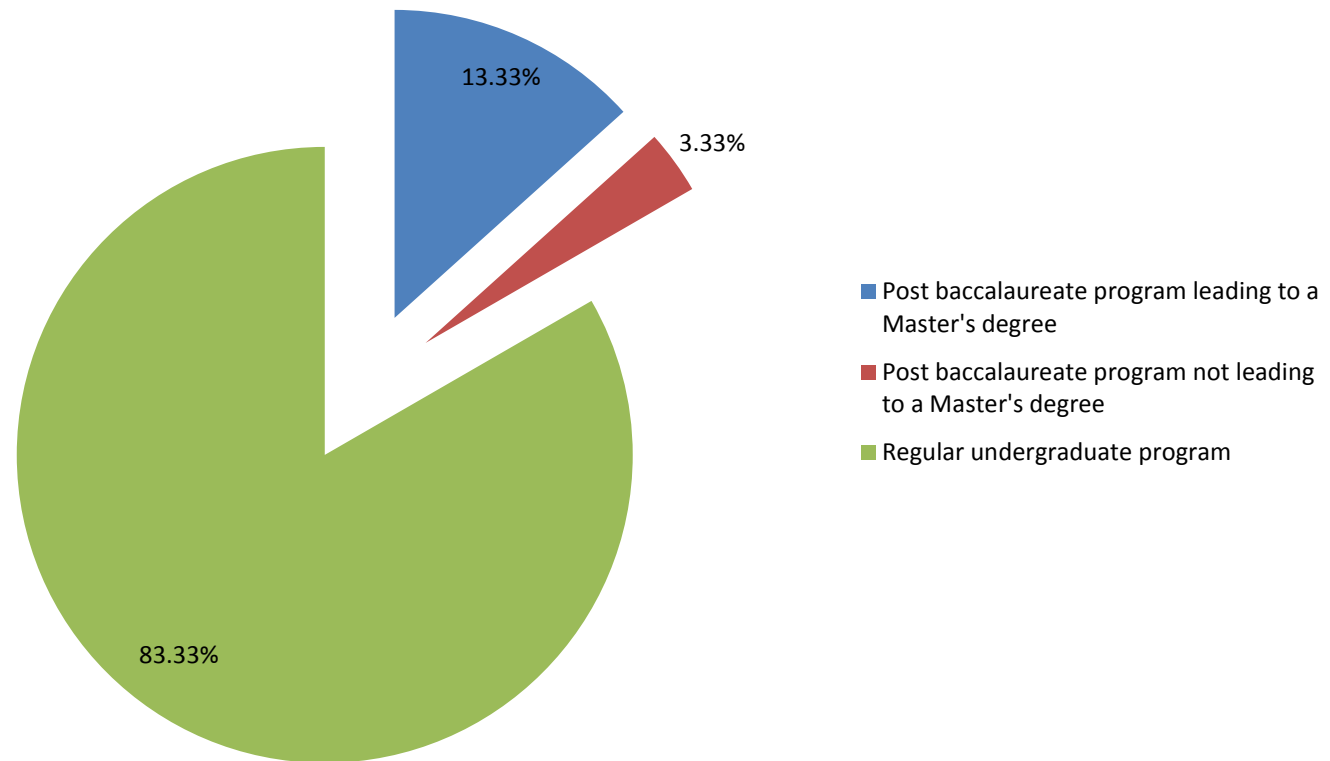

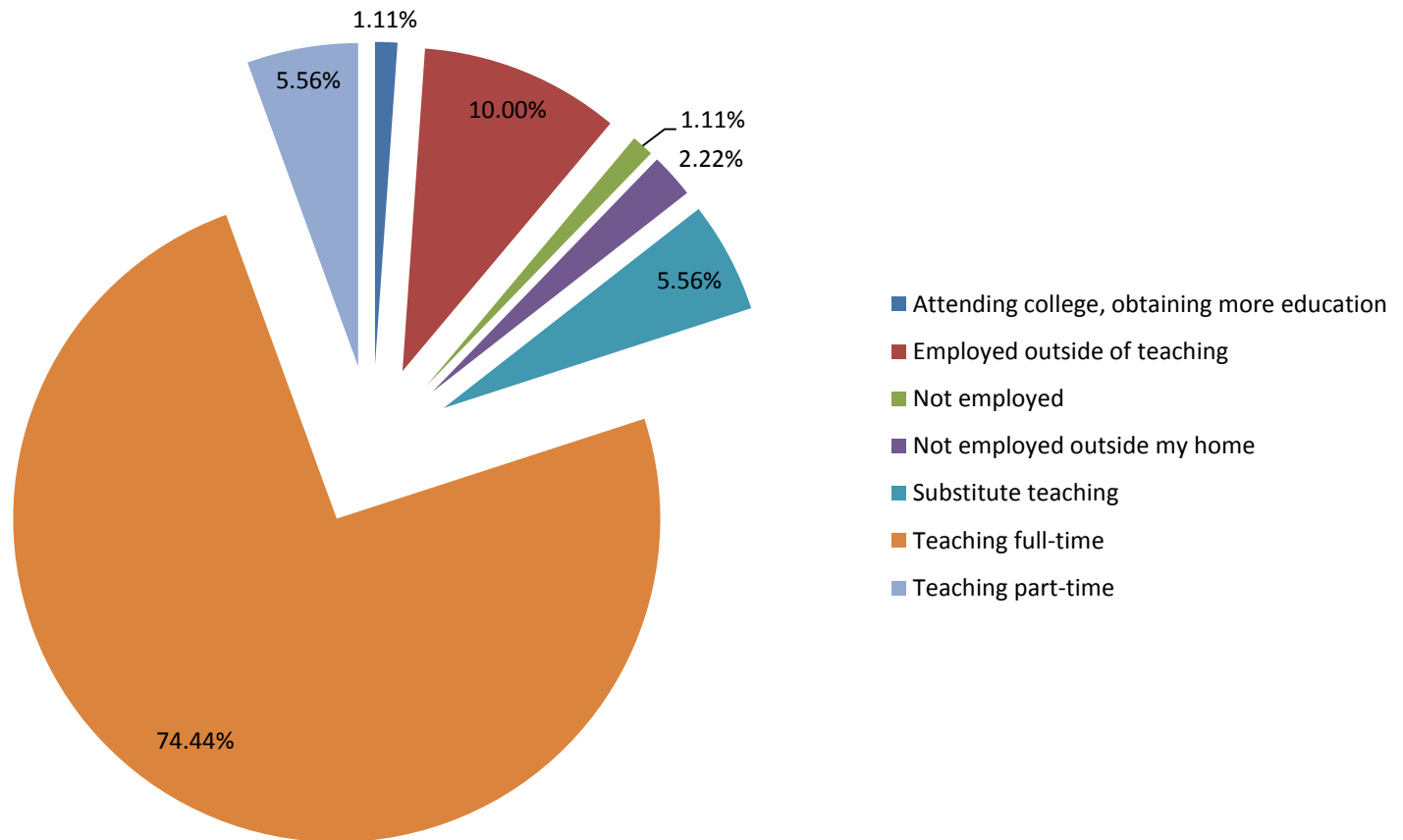
