


Faculty International Activities 2012-2013

International Activities Survey

UNC is in the process of developing an International Plan to enhance international initiatives across campus. This survey focused on accomplishments in international arenas conducted by UNC faculty, administrators, and staff. A survey and open-ended questions were provided by faculty. Out of the 180 comments provided by faculty, the countries referenced most often were Germany, Japan, Egypt, Mexico, Russia, and Thailand. 




Led a UNC-sponsored study abroad group	17	15.18%








