

Career Services Alumni Survey Analysis

The 2010-2011 Alumni Survey was conducted during March and April 2013 by the Office of Assessment at the University of Northern Colorado. All alumni from the College of Education and Behavioral Sciences who graduated in Summer 2010, Fall 2010, and Spring 2011 were given the opportunity to provide information about their employment status and pursuit of graduate-level education (Undergraduate N = 136, Graduate N = 398). Of these alumni, 22 undergraduate alumni (16%) and 71 graduate alumni (18%) responded to the survey.
