



Bin Types



6 and 40 Gallon Blue Desk-Side Bins

Located in classrooms and offices.
These smaller bins are used specifically for paper recycling.

28 Gallon Blue Collection Bins (rectangle or round)



Located in department main offices and hallways.

64 Gallon Blue Tote Bins (paper, commingle or cardboard)

Located in hallways and outside collection areas and are individually labeled for the type of materials collected. These are also used for event recycling.



64 Gallon Gray Confidential Bins

Located in department offices and workrooms across campus. These bins are locked to secure contents before shredding and are available upon request only.

Metal and Cardboard Bins

Apart from the more popular blue plastic recycling bins, UNC has a variety of other recycle containers located throughout campus, including cardboard and metal receptacles.



Recycle Center Cabinets



In the newer buildings on campus, convenient areas have been designated for recycling with built-in cabinets located in hallways. Paper, commingle, and trash can be discarded in these areas.

Recycle Center Outdoor



Recently, UNC purchased new outdoor recycling location that will help students, faculty, staff, and visitors sort recycling items from waste located outside major buildings. Paper, commingle, and trash can be discarded in these areas.
