Announcements/Chair's Report (Levin): We will have two items at Faculty Senate's next meeting. We are accepting nominations for APC Chair next year. Cieminski nominated Levin; Levin accepts. Benedict self-nominates for Vice Chair next year. We will continue nominations and then vote at our next APC meeting.

Reports from Councils:

Graduate Council (Cieminski): We are meeting this Thursday, no report.

Liberal Arts Council (Muller): Our last LAC meeting is tomorrow. We are finishing up indirect assessments, and direct assessments of science courses. We are working on a MEMO letter to unit leads/deans to be sent in May. We will hold an in-person workshop during contracts week. Canvas workshops will be offered too.

Professional Education Council (Mahovsky): No report.

Undergraduate Council (Welsh): We have the LMS item today.

Student Senate (Michell): Executive branch elections were held this past week. Everyone ran unopposed. Voted on Student Programming Allocation Fund (SPA).

Special Reports:

- Matchet reported on All-Faculty Conference held last week where micro-credentials were discussed.
 - o SB22-192 mandates greater use of stackable credentials.
- UNC units are already interested in offering stackable micro-credentials.
- New definitions to be given by CDHE next year.

Unfinished Business

• Department/School Definitions: APC reviewed Article 13 document back from Codification DISCUSSION: *Review of Sections 3-13-102, 3-13-103, 3-13-103(1)*

MOTION: There is a motion to send APC's department/school definitions document to Faculty Senate. Mahovsky firsts, Cieminski seconds.

VOTE: The motion passes by unanimous voice vote.

• Learning Management Systems (LMS) Use Policy (Codification):

DISCUSSION:

- APC would like to see due dates made available to students in a reasonable amount of time, grades made available, so students know their current grade, and a requirement for all faculty to use LMS for uploading a current course syllabus.
- o It was mentioned that course start and end-dates in Canvas LMS control user access.
- Wording of (IV): "Academic units may implement policies for the use of the LMS among instructional staff delivering their courses."
- Current wording of (III): "Sufficient detail must be provided to demonstrate that the evaluation is not prejudiced or capricious."
 - o It was mentioned that in above sentence, the word "arbitrary" should be used instead of "not prejudiced."
 - o It was confirmed that the current BPM language states: "...not arbitrary or capricious or a violation of policy."
- \circ Section X Funding.

MOTION: The motion to send this document to Faculty Senate. Benedict firsts, Wieben seconds. VOTE: The motion passes by unanimous voice vote.
