 - Add "fifteen" before "(15)" and "thirty" before" (30)"
 - Add "i.e., LAC" after "general education"
 - Edit the last bullet point sentence as follows: "Associate of Arts (A.A.) degree if they have completed all thirty-one (31) required credits of the statewide General Eeducation (i.e., LAC) requirements."
