Unfinished Business

- Senate Action 1113: Evaluation, Promotion, Tenure
- Review Committees, Boards, and Councils Bylaws
- Definitions
 - The Committee addressed the definitions for: In Loco Parentis, Joint Retrenchment Committee, Multidisciplinary or Interdisciplinary Activities, Overall Evaluation, and Parent (Jacqui will research)
- Faculty Senate Bylaws
 - From Jacqui: The redline to Faculty Senate Bylaw Article III(B) addresses sub-delegations to advisory committees from the Faculty Senate Chair to a designee, provided the designation is approved by the CAO or President. It appears this may conflict with draft Article IV(F) and Article V(F), which state that the FWC and APC respectively shall serve as representatives to advisory committees in the Senate Chair's absence, rather than permitting sub-delegates to be appointed by the Senate Chair (pending CAO or Pres approval) as set forth in Article III(B). Sorry I didn't recognize this previously and raise it during Codification Committee. But, I wanted to flag it for you all. As between them, I would recommend Article III(B) be retained and Articles IV(F) and V(F) be stricken so it's cleaner, internally consistent, and in congruence with Board Policy Manual 1-1-207.
 - The Committee approved the changes proposed by General Counsel. We eliminated the following subject to FSEC approval:
Article IV - The Faculty Welfare Committee (FWC)
 - F. The FWC chair or designee from the FWC shall serve as a representative of the

Senate on the advisory committees of the CAO when the Senate is not represented by the Senate chair or Senate Vice Chair.

Article V - The Academic Policies Committee (APC)

F. The APC chair or designee from APC shall serve as a representative of the Senate on the advisory committees of the CAO when the Senate is not represented by the Senate chair or Senate Vice Chair.

New Business

- The Committee agreed that the Dean's Council (2-3-106 (4)(b)) reference can remain as is.
