- Definitions
  - On the recommendation of General Counsel Rich Fredericks, the Committee decided to change the current definition of Parent in the BPM from:
    - Parent. A faculty member who is a biological parent, adoptive parent, foster parent, guardian, or a spouse of a parent, including a faculty member using a surrogate/gestational carrier.

TO the Federal FMLA definition:

- Parent: The biological, adoptive, step, or foster parent for a minor child, or who stands in loco parentis to, or is the legally appointed guardian for, a minor child.
- o Rich Fredericks will ask former General Counsel, Satriana, what he meant by "needs some work" for "Personnel Decision."
- o "Primary Care Giver" and "Program Area" were also discussed.

#### **New Business**

- 2-3-901(1) Time Guidelines. (from FWC)
  - The Committee suggested wording on the last sentence of (a) through (d):
    - "Years of credit awarded at the time of hire count as years of performance."

Was altered to read:

- "Years of credit awarded at the time of hire count toward years of completion"
- Retroactive Degree Conferral (from APC)

    - Delete "make every effort to" in the first sentence

- Change "did not" to "fail to" in the third sentence
- Change "entered in the academic record" to "recorded" in the last sentence of the second paragraph

- Adding a time limit
