For both the Graduate and Undergraduate Catalog, CC changed:

Degree Conferral Policy

UNC confers degrees three times each year: after the conclusion of the Fall, Spring, and Summer terms. The official date of conferral will be listed on official transcripts and the diplomas. The conferral date is either the date of commencement (for Fall and Spring semesters) or the last day of the Summer semester. Transcripts and diplomas listing the final degree are typically available 4 to 5 weeks after the end of the term to allow time for the registrar's office to verify that all degree requirements have been completed (See <u>Semester Academic</u> <u>Calendar</u>).

Note: Degrees will not be conferred prior to the end of a Fall, Spring or Summer term. A student who completes all requirements may request an official "Pending Conferral Letter" from the Office of the Registrar if needed prior to the date final transcripts and degrees are available.

Academic records will be locked upon degree conferral. Under no circumstances will changes be made to the academic record after a degree has been conferred.
