- Fleming reported that Veteran's Week events were successful. Friday's BOT meeting was bookended by veteran services presentations. Fleming mentioned that it would be nice to continue featuring faculty members at BOT meetings.
- She shared that UNC had a successful sports weekend in basketball, football, and volleyball.

Unfinished Business

- Haddad asked Senbet about the progress of the FPAC survey. He was curious if the Dean's surveys were also being reviewed. Senbet said they are meeting this week with Dana from 360, and Jacqui to review the questions for all administrators. Once reviewed, suggested questions will be sent to FPAC.
- Fleming added that it is a survey, and not an evaluation. The survey provides feedback that can be used in the evaluation.
- *Only the President has a 360 evaluation every three to five years.*
- Sileo and Senbet suggested seeking questions from the Deans, CSC, and PASC. Input from students and 360 reviews for all administrators was also discussed.
