Academic Policies Committee Motion: Incomplete Policy

MOTION: The Academic Policies Committee recommends amendments to the catalog to clarify the policy for incomplete grading.

Toewe outlined the rationale for the motion, to clarify the incomplete policy and give examples of factors not acceptable for consideration of an incomplete grade.

AMENDMENT: In paragraph #2 strike sentence #1: "Students must be passing the course at the time that in Incomplete is requested unless the instructor determines that there are extenuating circumstances to assign an Incomplete even if the student in not passing the course." Paragraph #1 already outlines "extenuating circumstances": DeKrey.

SECOND: Senbet.

ADDITIONAL DISCUSSION:

- Feinstein recommended a statement at the beginning stating the intent/purpose of the incomplete policy (recommendation for all policies).
- Glen asked for clarification of which catalog information is used when a policy change occurs midsemester. Toewe will bring the topic up at the next APC meeting.
- Other suggestions: Paragraph 4: Revise to read: "When completing an Incomplete grade, student should not register for the course a second time."

Toewe recommended that the motion be remanded back to APC for additional discussion. Senate members agreed.
