Unfinished Business

- **Probation Exemption Policy** Codification feedback
 - Reviewed edits from Codification
 - Grammatical changes, no substantive changes
 - APC accepts the changes from Codification and is ready to move the policy to Senate.
- Exploring and Seeking Catalog Narrative Updates Codification feedback
 - Reviewed edits from Codification
 - Grammatical changes, no substantive changes
 - Question about "referral assistance" in the section about Soar
 - Soar provides students with referral assistance to departments, schools, and campus resources.
 - URSA direction references/advisor lookup Heiny will follow up with language that reflects the current instructions.
 - APC will review an updated clean copy next time (3/30) before sending to Senate in April.
- Course Purge Policy review updates
 - Reviewed a revised draft incorporating suggestions from Senate
 - Course Purge is currently tabled at Senate.
 - HLC requires that courses and programs must be current.
 - The catalog cycle for the Undergraduate level is 6 years, while the cycle for some Graduate programs is up to 8 years.

- The language for the Graduate catalog has been changed to reflect the 8-year limit.
- GOAL Program Proposal for participation in commencement
 - There will not be any students coming up for graduation this semester, so there is time to prepare language for inclusion in next year's catalog.
 - Language can be submitted via the curriculum workflow, which will be open for submissions starting April 15th.
 - Toewe will follow up with Christina Ruffatti with a recommendation for her to write up a catalog language proposal to bring to APC.

New Business

- Campus-wide policy for academic misconduct
 - Jeff Gilis has asked APC to consider a campus-wide policy addressing academic misconduct.
 - Currently instructors determine how to handle instances of academic misconduct.
 - Toewe will have a conversation with Tuck, the Dean of Students, to clarify the picture of how a campus-wide policy might be implemented and what impacts such a policy might have.
