<u>Unfinished Business</u>

• Academic Appeal Procedure Amendment Proposals

- o The proposal has been fully vetted by Codification, including Dan Satriana.
- o Working day language has been made to line up with intent of calendar day language.
 - Calendar day language is used where appropriate in non-contractual periods.
- o The timeline for review has been slimmed to within the academic year.
- o If deadlines are not met, the process stops and cannot be re-opened.
 - Deadline extensions may be granted before a deadline expires.

- o The size of the hearing panel has been restored per Luedloff's recommendation.
- o Academic appeals currently underway will follow the current policy.
 - Only new appeals would fall under purview of the new proposal once approved.
- Welsh will create a short paragraph summary to explain to Faculty Senate the differences between the current policy and the proposal.
- o The policy will not require two reads at Senate since it is a revision of an existing policy.

• Honorary Degree Process – Senate Action Form #1103

o President Feinstein has a contribution, but it hasn't been presented at this time.

• GOAL Program – Proposal for participation in commencement

- o Talks with Commencement are on hold due to a question of program sustainability as far as funding.
- The first students are slated to compete not this May but the following May, so there is time to examine options.

New Business

• Two items from Chris Freeman, Director of SOAR:

- Suspension exemption for first-semester students who completed dual/concurrent enrollment at UNC
- o Fresh Start time reduction for returning students
 - The Provost's Office, Stephanie Torrez, and Chris Freeman are rethinking both items.

Catalog Prerequisite Changes – Question from Oscar Levin

- The Registrar's Office has addressed some of the concerns (such as typos) in how the prerequisite information is displayed.
- o The Registrar's Office can implement the information the department wishes to communicate; if any changes need to be made, the department can confirm with RO.
- o Toewe will reach out to Levin; there doesn't seem to be an issue under the purview of APC to address.
