<u>Codification</u> (Schuttler) – We worked on a policy proposal format template; the new item from APC is on this format. The template is designed for policy proposals going to Senate to make it easier for committees to track pertinent information and the review process.

<u>Faculty Welfare</u> (Luger) – We will take up the request for further review of the RSCW Misconduct policy. Satriana will attend the next Welfare meeting to help the committee work through the policy issues.

Salary Equity (Greene) – We are bringing the pay distribution plan to Senate next week.

### **Standing Reports**

Board of Trustees (Fischer) – No Report.

President (Feinstein) – CCHE discussed the possibility of mandating vaccines in higher education settings, but no additional recommendation or decision was reached. In Colorado so far, only Fort Lewis College has a vaccine mandate. Two emails were sent Friday regarding two incidents on campus: one related to graffiti of a racial slur and another related to complaints regarding a candidate for Student Body President using preferred pronouns in a divisive manner. Investigations are ongoing. Dialog across campus is happening.

<u>Provost</u> (Anderson) – Anderson acknowledged Toewe as one of the 2021 Distinguished Scholars. Letters for promotion, tenure, etc. were sent on Friday. Post-tenure review letters will go out this week.
