President (Feinstein): The VSIP applications submitted by faculty and staff are under review.

Provost (Anderson): Once VSIP final decisions have been reached and the employees notified,
Academic Affairs will work with Deans to determine pathways forward. The EBS and
PVA Dean searches are collecting applications. First round interviews for the Executive
Director of Extended Campus will be happening soon, and on campus interviews are
expected in the first half of November. I spoke with NHS Senators and chairs/directors to
set timeframes for identifying an interim Dean and initiating the NHS Dean search.

DISCUSSION: Spring academic schedule – There is no consensus at this time about whether to alter the Spring academic schedule; feedback from the colleges is mixed. Opinions are split concerning the semester starting later, finishing earlier, and/or changing Spring break. Academic Affairs will work closely with Students Affairs to coordinate alternate Spring break activities. We need to get a clear indication of students' concerns/opinions, across both undergraduate and graduate student populations. Anderson will follow up with Castro and the Student Senate.
