### 12. New Business

#### • Online Exam Proctoring – information item

- o Toewe presented a draft Online Exam Proctoring policy originating from Academic Affairs.
  - It is largely a budget issue in addition to being an academic issue.
  - With the current contract expiring, UNC needs a new policy for the next academic year.
  - Academic Affairs is welcoming feedback through the end of the semester.

DISCUSSION: concerns about the proposed limitations of the use of online proctoring; pros/cons of costs centralized versus student fees

#### • Mutually Exclusive Courses – catalog language update

- o Toewe presented catalog language updates on behalf of APC concerning mutually exclusive courses.
  - The update accounts for courses with "highly similar" content to be considered mutually exclusive.
    - The current policy only accounts for courses with "identical" content to be considered mutually exclusive.
  - Clearer guidance is now provided on how the grade replacement policy applies to mutually exclusive courses.

MOTION: APC – It is moved to approve the revised catalog language for mutually exclusive courses as presented.

VOTE: Approved by voice vote.

#### Promotion

- o Luger presented the Welfare committee's revisions to the Promotion policy (changes in yellow).
  - In addition to Welfare's updates, the President recommends additional changes (highlighted in green).
- o The Time Guidelines section for Instructors does not have a rank specification like the other sections. This has led to some variations in interpretation. The

Instructors section has been amended to say "regardless of rank" to remove the ambiguity and account for the possibility of different titles.

- o The Eligibility section has been amended for clarity and better readability.
  - The President's recommended language in this section provides further clarification on years of credit.

MOTION: Welfare – It is moved to approve the revised promotion policy.

FRIENDLY AMENDMENT: DeKrey moved to accept the additional changes recommended by the President. Luger accepts the friendly amendment.

VOTE: Approved by voice vote.

#### • Triennial review option for tenured full professors

- o Luger presented the Welfare committee's recommendation for creating a triennial review option for tenured full professors.
  - We chose to create/pilot the option for only tenured full professors since, unlike associate professors, there is no additional promotion step for full professors.
  - All years will continue to be subject to review, and the triennial review option does not preclude more frequent reviews.
    - If merit pay is implemented, the most recent annual/biennial/triennial review will be used to determine merit pay eligibility.
  - If the triennial review option is approved, multiple policy areas in University Regulations and Board Policy would need to be updated. In addition to UR 3-3-801(2), updates are needed for:
    - UR additional references: Department Chair Evaluation and Faculty Compensation Procedures
    - BPM Part 8 Faculty Evaluation
    - BPM Post-Tenure Review
  - After a faculty grievance last year, the President recommended we address the issue of what happens when faculty fail to submit evaluation materials. We have included a new stipulation in Board Policy Part 8 Faculty Evaluation for both the Annual/Biennial/Triennial Review and Comprehensive Review sections:
    - Failure to submit a dossier for review shall result in an overall evaluation rating of unsatisfactory.

MOTION: Welfare – It is moved to approve the creation of a triennial review option for tenured full professors and approve the related policies as amended.

VOTE: Approved by voice vote, 1 opposed.

#### 13. Comments to the Good of the Order

• Luger thanked Feinstein and Satriana for working out agreements for updating the promotion policy and creating triennial review.
