  - How to clarify the Eligibility section, 2-3-901(4), particularly concerning credit toward promotion.
    - Credit from UNC and prior institutions/experience
  - Break the first paragraph into two.
- o We will resume discussion at the next meeting.

## • Triennial review for tenured full professors

- The committee continued discussion of the option of creating triennial review for tenured, full professors.
  - Intent that tenured, full professors have an intermediate review at least once in each 6-year comprehensive review cycle
  - Feinstein is supportive of the idea.
- o Key items to consider:

- Relationship and timing between comprehensive and non-comprehensive reviews
  - Difference in evaluation criteria and purpose of the two types of review
  - Should annual/biennial/triennial reviews as a group be defined and what to call them: periodic, intermediate, non-comprehensive, etc.
- Clock reset and whether any single year may/may not be included in more than one annual/biennial/triennial review
  - Clock reset is the standard, which means any given year will not be included in more than one annual/biennial/triennial review.
- o The Tenured Full Professors section, 3-3-801(2)(f)(V), may need clarification.
  - Luger will consult Satriana.
