President (Feinstein) – Feinstein announced a plan for mid-year compensation increases.

Beginning in January, we will implement compensation adjustments for all faculty and staff. Full-time faculty and staff will receive a \$1,500 increase to their base salary; this increase will be prorated for part-time employees. The minimum wage for staff will be increased to \$15/hour, and the minimum wage for student employees will be increased to \$14/hour. Adjunct faculty and graduate teaching assistants will receive a one-time payment of \$250 as well. A formal announcement will be made after working through details with HR and Payroll.

#### DISCUSSION:

- Salary Equity will assist HR in creating an FAQ document to accompany the announcement to campus.
- The mid-year increases are not in lieu of salary increases for FY23. The FY23 salary pool will be finalized later in the Spring semester (perhaps in May). Salary Equity will work on a salary pool distribution model.
