



## Automatic Revalidation Of visa

Your expired visa may be automatically revalidated when you re-enter the United States from Canada, Mexico, or one of the adjacent islands listed below if

- your visit was less than thirty (30) days
- you have a valid SEVIS Form I-20 signed by DSO
- you have a valid Form I-94 – do NOT turn this over

### \*Adjacent Islands:

Saint Pierre	Haiti
The Bahamas	Martinique
Miquelon	Bermuda
Barbados	The Windward and Leeward Islands
The Dominican Republic	Trinidad
Jamaica	

### Criteria for NOT being eligible for automatic revalidation:

- The student applied for a new visa and it has not been issued
- The student applied for a new visa and was denied
- The student has a terminated SEVIS record indicating that he/she is out of status
- The student has been out of the U.S. for more than 30 days
- This student is a citizen of Cuba, Iran, Iraq, Libya, North Korea, Sudan, or Syria

**NOTE: IN THIS SITUATION ONLY do not give up your I-94 when you are leaving the country. In order to receive automatic revalidation of your visa, you must have it when you return to the U.S.**
