**First-Level Heading: Centered Upper and Lower-Case, Bold Font**

Second-Level Heading: Centered Upper and Lower-case, Use Plain Font

*Third-Level Side Heading in Italics or Bold Font, Upper and Lower-Case*

Fourth-level side heading, sentence style capitalization use plain font

*Fifth-level, italics or bold font, paragraph indent ending in a period.* The paragraph continues on the same line as the heading. This heading is not adjusted if it's longer than any length.
