Competition Guidelines

- 1. Homecoming Week is open to the entire UNC community. Classifications will be made according to recognized Fraternity & Sorority organizations, Residence Halls, any Recognized Student Organization that is chartered. Groups will only compete against other groups in their classification.
- 2. All competitions must be completed and/or performed in good taste. "In good taste" is defined as behavior that aligns with UNC's values of respect, honesty, civility, and responsibility. Any verbal or physical display that does not uphold these values during Homecoming/Spirit Week will result in disqualification from the day's events and referred to the Dean of Students' Office for further action. This includes not following mask and social distancing guidelines!
- **3.** Disqualification from any event will result in team notification and forfeiture of points. If teams are not following COVID guidelines i.e.: wearing masks properly or social distancing during events this will result in immediate loss of points and possible disqualification. As well as referral to the Dean of Student's Office for violating COVID-19 guidelines.
- **4.** All decisions made by the Office of Student Life, the University Program Council, and the Homecoming Week Committee are final.
- **5.** Participant registration during Homecoming Spirit Week events gives consent for the University of Northern Colorado to use photos for promotional and/or identification purposes.
- 6. Alcohol and drug usage policy: Alcohol/drug usage is strictly prohibited at any UNC affiliated event- **including virtual events!** Evidence of violation of this policy this could result in forfeiture of points and further disciplinary consequences.

COVID GUIDELINES FOR ALL 2020 HOMECOMING PROGRAMS

- Face coverings must be worn properly (covering both nose and mouth) for the duration of ALL in-person programs and virtual program submissions that involve multiple people (10 or less).
- Social distancing measures will be taken for all in person programs. Participants must always maintain 6 feet of distance from persons not in their household during programs affiliated with UNC's homecoming.
- In person attendance and participation is **not** mandatory for any of these events! Virtual participation is encouraged.
- If you are considered part of a high-risk population for contracting COVID-19, please use the remote participation options for all programs!
- If at any point throughout the week you are showing signs of illness or have come into contact with someone that is suspected to have COVID-19 please stay home and participate virtually in Homecoming Week programs! Conduct daily symptom check by clicking here.

Not complying with any of these rules could result in disqualification of Homecoming Week for your organization and further disciplinary consequences from the University.

Residence Hall Groups & Student Clubs / Orgs!

- Your group requires at least FIVE (5)* people on a team and must be enrolled in UNC courses.
- Rosters must be submitted to <u>UPC@unco.edu</u> by October 5 at 5 PM with the subject line "(Organization Name) Official Roster".

Fraternity and Sorority Groups!

- Your group requires at least SIX (6)* people on a team and must be enrolled in UNC courses.
- Rosters must be submitted to <u>UPC@unco.edu</u> by October 5 at 5 PM with the subject line "(Organization Name) Official Roster".

Competition v. Non-Competition

Competitions: Competition events <u>will</u> have 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place opportunities for points.

- Can-Sculpture
- Digital Spirit Banners
- Battle of the Bears

Non-Competitions: Non-Competition events <u>will not</u> have 1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place opportunities for points. However, they will have point opportunities for groups that have 50% or more of their team present. The team that has the highest attendance ratio for the day will receive the most points!

Thursday- Digital Spirit Banner Submissions: Points will be awarded for... 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.

Friday- Battle of the Bears: Points will be awarded for... 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

Saturday- RHA Magician/Illusionist will be awarded for... attendance

POINT SYSTEM BREAKDOWN

Competition based events will have a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place point opportunity. Those that place in the top 3 will receive either 10, 15, or 20 points. If your group doesn't place you won't receive any points.

Attendance based events will have the opportunity to receive 10 points if over 50% of members from your team's roster fills out the attendance google form. Google form links will be put in the chat feature for all virtual events. If your group has the highest amount of attendance for the day from people listed on your team's roster you will receive an additional 5 points!

The points for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd competition-based events are as follows:

1st Place: 20 Points
 2nd Place: 15 Points
 3rd Place: 10 Points

Digital Spirit Banners

- 1. Spirit Banners need to be emailed to <u>UPC@unco.edu</u> with the subject line "(Insert Organization Name Here) Spirit Banner Submission" on Thursday October 8th by 5 pm.
- 2. To decorate the banner teams must use a web design program (Free options: Canva, BeFunky, FotoJet) that incorporates the theme (Bear-a-palooza), their organization's logo, and demonstrates creativity!
- 3. Banners will be posted to our social media and must be able to fit in a square Instagram post! The winning banners will be printed and displayed around campus.

Spirit Banners represent your Fraternity / Sorority Group, Residence Hall Group, or Student Club / Org. Group. The creativity that goes into these digital spirit banners are for your group to decide but we do encourage you to keep in mind the spirit of a UNC Bear and the Homecoming 2020 theme: Bear-a-palooza!

Final Reminders!

- If you post your organization's submission on your personal account use #Homecoming2020!
- Note: Only the registered teams of Spirit Week will be considered for printing and featured on social media.

ANY Spirit Banners that include but are not limited to hate speech, derogatory language/images, explicit content, drugs or alcohol use, etc. will result in disqualification from ALL Homecoming festivities. Rule of thumb: if you have to question whether or not it is offensive, do not use it.

Can-sculpture Guidelines

- 1. Submit pictures of your sculpture and a time-lapse video of representatives from your organization building your sculpture to <u>UPC@UNCO.edu</u> by 7 PM on Wednesday, October 7th. Please drop cans off at the Office of Student Life by 5 PM for counting!
- 2. Please remember that all Covid safety protocols must be followed for the building of your structure (6 feet apart, masks on, no more than 10 people). Feel free to build in shifts or have your most skilled stackers build on behalf of your team!
- 3. **Time-lapse rules:** Must be submitted to <u>UPC@unco.edu</u> by 7 PM on Wednesday, October 7. All participants shown in the time lapse *must* be wearing face coverings properly and follow social distancing measures (6 feet apart). You are welcome to use a cell phone or any other type of technology to record this. This can also be recorded before this date and submitted early! As long as cans are brought to the Office of Student Life by 5 PM for counting!
- 4. Each team must purchase or collect their own canned goods to build the sculpture. (Food can NOT be collected from Bear Pantry or other local food banks. This would result in disqualification from Homecoming NO EXCEPTIONS.)
- 5. Cans and/or boxes must be nonperishable food items and brought to the Office of Student Life by 5 PM for counting!
- 6. Sculpture must be comprised of food in the form of cans or boxes (different point values listed below).
- 7. Food cannot be damaged in the process of building the sculpture. If damaged, the point value from the item will be removed from the total score.
- 8. No gluing, welding, or other permanent affixing of cans allowed. Any type of tape is permissible (must be able to be easily removed).
- 9. No opened food, glass, or alcohol allowed.
- 10. Follow safety and COVID precautions when building your sculpture.

Can-Sculpture Point System

One can-good/boxed item will be worth 1 point! Size of organization is considered in the amount of cans that are brought! Points will be calculated based on number of individuals in an organization listed on the roster and the number of cans that are provided (e.g. 3/10 people or 6/20 people both = 30% of team attended).

Counting will occur the evening of October 7th in the Office of Student Life.

The judges will rate the sculpture in the pictures and Time-Lapse according to the four categories (creativity/originality, relation to Homecoming theme, quality of design, and completion) for additional points ranging from 0-50 (see rubric).


After the final points are determined, there will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner that will follow the normal point system (1st place= 20 points, 2nd place= 15 points, 3rd place= 10 points).


Submission Rules:

- Photos and time-lapse video of the structure being built must be submitted to <u>UPC@unco.edu</u> by 7 PM on Wednesday, October 7th
- Please remember that all covid safety protocols must be followed for the building of your structure (6 feet apart, masks on, no more than 10 people). Feel free to build in shifts or have your most skilled stackers build on behalf of your team!
- Bring cans to the Office of Student Life by 4 PM for counting!

Can-Sculpture Rubric

Battle of the Bears

- 1. COVID guidelines must be followed for the entire duration of this program! That includes remaining six feet apart from others during dancing, wearing masks/face coverings, and having no more than 6 people perform at any given time.
- 2. Music must be turned in as a digital file by 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, October 6th (emailed to gion2166@bears.unco.edu <u>and rose.glaser@unco.edu</u>). Music for performances must be pre-approved by the Homecoming Week Committee. You will be notified immediately if there is a concern with your selection.
- 3. Battle of the Bears routines should be minimum 3 minutes and MAXIMUM 6 minutes. Your routine must adhere to social distancing guidelines! All participants must remain at least 6 feet apart from others at all times and wear masks.
- **4. Performance Options:** (*if your organization has access to record on your own we do appreciate that so others can use the in-person recording space*)

Option 1: You can have up to 6 performers on your team and submit a 3-6 minute video recording of your routine. You can record and submit this video on your own or sign up for a timeslot here: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/9040D49ADAB2BA6FB6-battle) and a UPC coordinator will record your routine and submit this to the judges. For in person recording, performers will report to the Campus Commons Multipurpose Room at their designated time and perform their routine while a UPC coordinator video tapes the performance.

Option 2: You can have up to 18 performers on your team and submit a 3-6 minute video recording of your routine. There can only be 6 people performing on the screen at a time, however, you are welcome to take 2 minute "shifts" of up to 3 groups of 6 people performing at a time and submit this video for judging. Record and submit your routine to <u>rose.glaser@unco.edu</u> <u>and</u> <u>gion2166@bears.unco.edu</u> by 6 PM on Friday, October 9th. All COVID guidelines must be followed for this option.

- **5. In Person Performance Option:** Dance representatives will sign up for a time slot using this link: https://www.signupgenius.com/go/9040D49ADAB2BA6FB6-battle) Performers will report to the Campus Commons Multipurpose Room and perform while a UPC coordinator video tapes and live streams the performance on social media.
- 6. Virtual Performance Option: Record and submit your video routine to rose.glaser@unco.edu unco.edu by 5 PM on Thursday, October 8th. All COVID guidelines must be followed for this option.
- 7. All team members must remain 6 feet apart from each other at all times, wear masks/face coverings, and no more than 10 people may be on the stage or in the video at any given time!
- 8. The following items are PROHIBITED, and any use of these items will result in a disqualification from Homecoming (no exceptions): Confetti, Feather boas, Glitter (including face and hair glitter), Silly String, Food Items (ESPECIALLY CAKE/PIE). Please no use of liquids or any materials that would be deemed to "make a mess." If you need clarification on the listed items, contact Rose or LD prior to the event (contact information is listed on Page 2).
- 9. Judging Criteria includes talent, costuming, entertainment value, and relevancy towards
 Homecoming Theme as well as following COVID guidelines (See Rubric Below).
