GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT LOGBOOK

- 1. Notebooks used should be lose-leaf or spiral-bound and should only contain material related to the project.
- 2. Size of the notebooks should accommodate 8 ½" X 11" pages.
- 3. Each day's activity should be recorded on a separate page, beginning at the top of the page.
- 4. The entry format for each day's recorded activity should be dated and contain the activity for that day, the hours and the place of the activity.
- 5. At the end of each week's entries, provide a signature line for the agency supervisor's signature.
