Every UNC student must meet the following requirements in order to graduate with a bachelor's degree: earn a minimum of 120 semester credit hours; possess a minimum of a 2.00 cumulative grade point average; have at least 31 credit hours in courses designated as Liberal Arts Curriculum; meet all degree requirements in the student's major field of study. Each major and/or emphasis may have additional requirements necessary for graduation. Students must consult with their major advisor to receive information on any additional graduation requirements.

**Admission Requirement –** Academic good standing.

**Minor Required – Required.** This requirement may also be met with either a second major or at least 18 credit hours in a second European language other than English.

1. All work to be counted toward the degree must be beyond the first year level.

- 2. Unless otherwise noted, all courses with a FR, GER, or SPAN prefix are conducted in French, German, or Spanish respectively. Courses with the EUR prefix are conducted in English, with some reading and/or writing assignments in each student's language of emphasis, as determined by the instructor.
- 3. Students must demonstrate competency in certain areas of language activity: oral and written proficiency in foreign language, ability to apply one's knowledge of the culture to appropriate situations in a foreign language environment.
- 4. To graduate with degree in European Languages and Cultures, students must have a 2.5 GPA in those courses that count toward the major and were taken at UNC.
- 5. Opportunity for study abroad junior year.
