

Minor in Japanese

Minor Requirements **18 credits**

The Minor in Japanese introduces students to Japanese culture and civilization and provides students the means to develop intermediate spoken and written proficiency in Japanese language. Students completing this program will be prepared to begin to work, travel, or advance to further study in Japanese.

Required Minor Credits **12 credits**

Students who demonstrate first-year language competency in either Chinese or Japanese may bypass the 102 course and take 15 hours of electives rather than 12

FL 296, FL 395, and JAPN 422 must focus on Japan or be taught in Japanese.

Students must maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.5 in those courses that count towards the minor and that are taken at UNC.
