The Department of Modern Languages at the University of Northern Colorado seeks an Instructor of German to begin fall semester 2016. Teaching load varies from 9 to 12 credit hours per semester, complemented by service obligations. Courses include beginning and intermediate skills-building classes that meet three days per week with accompanying online instruction. Opportunities for upper division language and culture courses are possible. Service may include participation in student extracurricular activities, recruitment and retention activities or other support functions. This is a full time, non-tenure track position. Contract renewable annually. Minimum degree requirement: M.A. in German, Ph.D. in German preferred. Additional requirements: Native or near-native fluency in both German and English, ability to deliver instruction partially in an online environment, previous successful teaching experience, interest in program development and renewal. Applications will be considered until the position is filled. Courses commence August 22, 2016. The University of Northern Colorado is an AA/EO employer. The successful applicant will be appointed from the Humanities and Social Sciences Hiring Pool.
