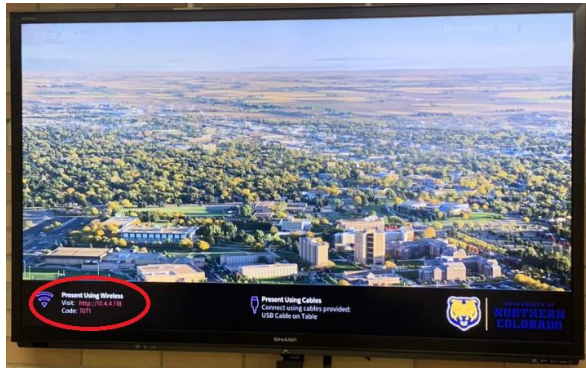
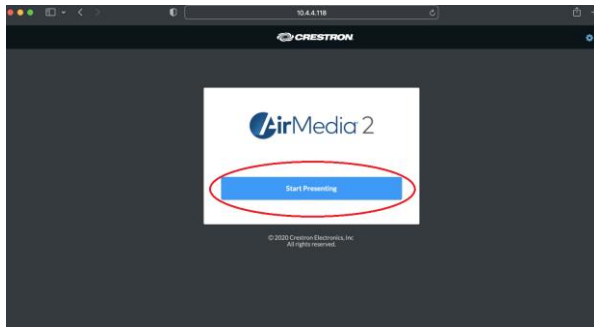


Using Crestron AirMedia with Macs

1. Turn TV on. The AirMedia screen should automatically be on. Locate the I.P. Address and code for your AirMedia in the lower left of screen.



2. Enter the I.P. Address in your internet browser. Click the "Start Presenting" button.



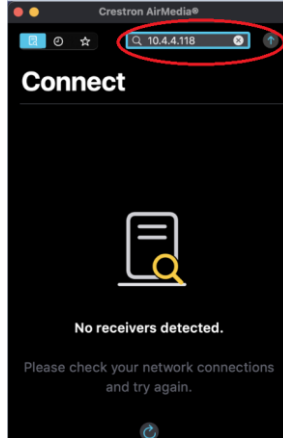
3. Click the "Mac" button to begin downloading the software.



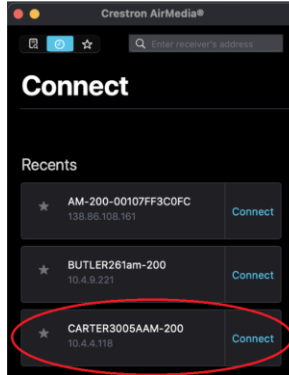
4. Look in your downloads for the downloaded AirMedia Icon (in this example it is in the Dock).



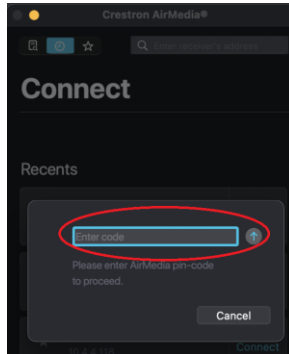
5. If the AirMedia device isn't listed, type the I.P. Address and click the arrow to search for it.



6. Once your AirMedia shows up, click on it (yours will be named something different than the example).



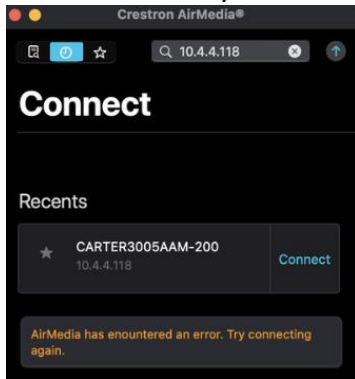
7. Enter the code from the bottom left of the TV screen that was referenced in step one above.



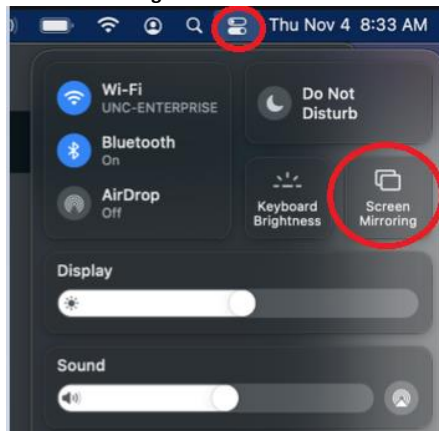

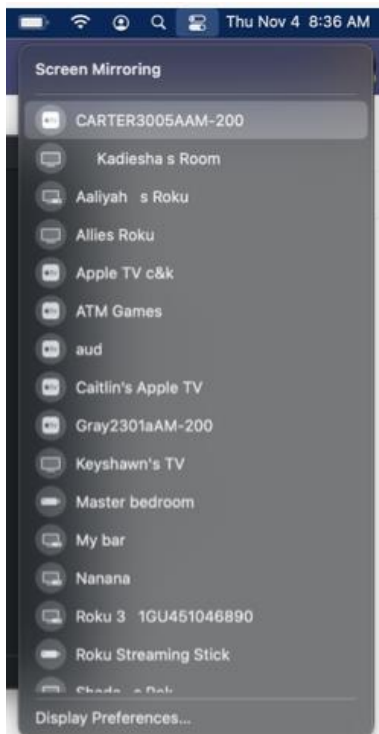
8. The connection will likely encounter an error. Go to step 9.



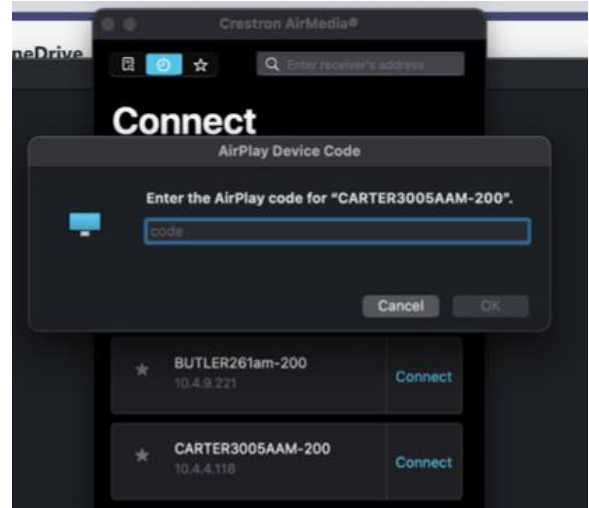
9. Go to the Control Center Icon (🔧) in your menu bar. When you click it, some system settings appear. Select "screen mirroring".



10. After selecting "Screen Mirroring", find your AirMedia.



11. You will need to enter the AirMedia code one last time. After this, your Mac image should show on the display.



12. To disconnect from AirMedia, go back to the Control Center and select the screen mirroring setting.



13. Click on the AirMedia name you are connected to and it will disconnect the session.
