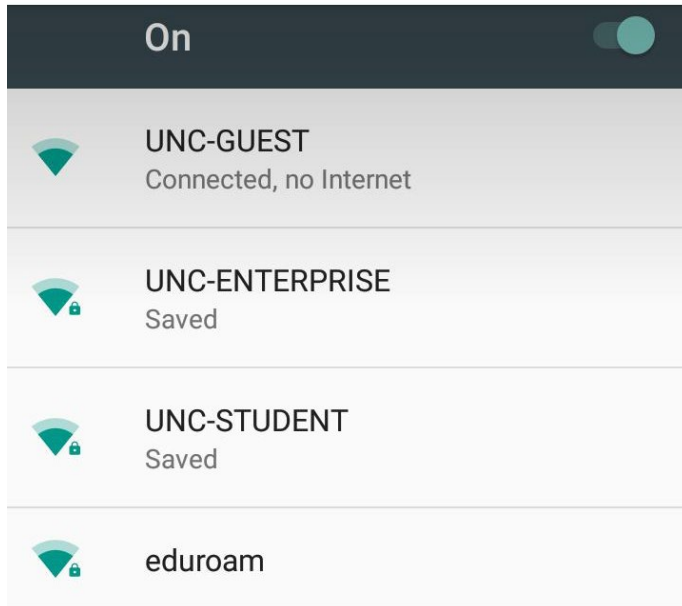


Android

Note: Before starting to connect, close all Internet Browsers including Firefox, Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, etc.

1. Open Settings – Wi-Fi
2. Click **UNC-Guest** in the list of wireless networks



3. Click on the notification, "Sign into Wi-Fi Network" This will open a browser to direct you to the Guest Portal



4. Read through UNC's Computing Acceptable Use Procedure and click **Accept**
