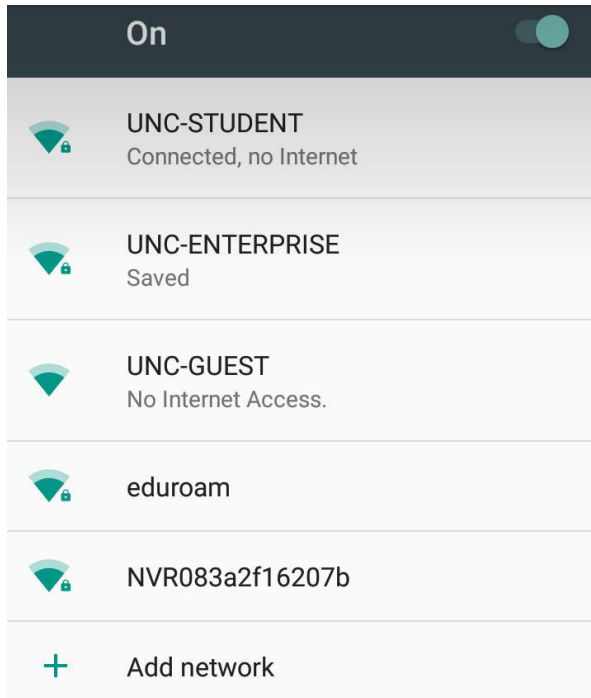


Android

Note: Before starting to connect, close all Internet Browsers including Firefox, Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, Safari, etc.

1. Open Settings – Wi-Fi
2. Click **UNC-Student** in the list of wireless networks




3. When prompted, enter the passphrase: **UNCStudent** (*case sensitive*)
4. Click on the notification, "Sign into Wi-Fi Network" This will open up a browser to direct you to the Student Portal
