



You will have content from past courses. Are you unsure about what to do with it? You can start fresh or adapt the content.

Start Fresh

...If you want to **rethink the design of your course** Canvas allows more flexibility in presentation and organization of content.



...If you want to **reconsider student engagement** Canvas fosters collaborative connections.



...If you **heavily use blogs or journals**. These are built differently in Canvas.



...If you **regularly use wikis and group tools** these are built differently in Canvas



...If your course has **outdated or extraneous materials**. Past courses that have been copied several times.



Adapt Content



...If your courses are **organized using folders and items**. They will appear logically into Modules in Canvas.



...If you **heavily rely on tests, surveys, and question pools**. These should import fairly well into Quizzes and Question Banks. Minor revisions needed.



...If **discussion forums are detailed and a pivotal part of your course**. These should import fairly well into Discussions.



...If you want to **save time**. Focus only on reorganizing the content that will fit the Canvas platform.
