As a member of the Learning through Engagement & Authentic Practices (LEAP) program at the University of Northern Colorado, you need to be fully committed to the program and understand your responsibilities. Please read your commitment:

- 1. I will follow the University of Northern Colorado's Standard of Conduct, knowing that a violation of these standards could result in dismissal from LEAP.
- 2. I understand that I must be a full-time undergraduate student enrolled in at least 12 credit hours in a Biology or Chemistry program each semester-eligible terms (renewable up to four years). I further understand that my cumulative GPA must remain at 2.75 or above. If my GPA falls below 2.75, at the discretion of the LEAP staff, I will be given at least one semester to show progression with a positive upward trend. In addition, I understand that the LEAP program is here to help me to succeed and I will comply and utilize the resources available to me and advised for me for student success.
- 3. I know it is important to attend the mandatory meetings with the LEAP Coordinator, Peer Mentors, and Faculty and attend workshops/events **and** complete any program assignments.
