This is a contract-renewable faculty position that reports to the Head of Library Research Services (LRS). This is a 12-month position with an expectation of scholarly activity and service.

The Health Sciences Liaison Librarian will demonstrate enthusiasm for working with students from a variety of diverse backgrounds, the ability to prioritize projects, and the ability to work in a collaborative and productive team environment. LRS librarians focus on liaison work, research support, instruction—especially for upper-division students, graduate students, and faculty members—and scholarly communication initiatives. This position offers opportunities for innovation and professional growth in all of these areas.

**Responsibilities:**

- Conduct proactive liaison outreach to health sciences departments within the College of Natural and Health Sciences
- Actively foster working relationships with health sciences faculty, staff, and students to create value-added services, resources, and programs
- Teach curriculum-integrated instruction sessions and library workshops at all degree levels
- Support student and faculty research by providing support for scholarly communication queries, instruction for data literacy, and promotion of the institutional repository, Scholarship & Creative Works @ Digital UNC
- Provide research assistance to students and faculty in health sciences through individual and group consultations
- Create research and resource guides and materials based on demonstrated need
- Participate in the selection and assessment of print and digital resources in assigned subject areas to support research and teaching
- Maintain current knowledge of librarianship and academic health sciences research
- Develop relationships with UNC health-oriented research centers and institutes where appropriate
- Other duties as assigned

**Minimum Qualifications**

- Earned master's degree from an ALA-accredited library school or program by start date
- One year of professional library experience
- Evidence of oral and written communication skills
- Experience with library liaison work or facilitating outreach activities

## Preferred Qualifications

- Experience with library resources and tools that support faculty and student research in the health sciences
- Experience with instruction
- Experience with data literacy education
- Knowledge of scholarly communication trends and issues
- Ability to manage multiple projects or priorities
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively
- A demonstrated record of scholarly activity or service to the profession

Applicants must complete an online application form and attach a letter of application, highlighting suitability for the position, and curriculum vitae, including names of three references with their mail and email addresses, and telephone numbers.
