Embedding Tutorials into Canvas

Embedding the Entire Tutorial

1. Login to Canvas
2. From the left sidebar menu Select Commons
3. Search for Undergraduate Research Tutorial
4. Select *Undergraduate Research Tutorial (University of Northern Colorado)*
5. From the right menu "Import into Canvas," select the course(s) you want to import into
6. Select the green button "Import into Course"

Embedding Individual Tutorials

1. Login to Canvas
2. Select Canvas from the left sidebar menu
3. Search for Undergraduate Research Tutorial and include the Module number you want to include (e.g. Undergraduate research tutorial module 2)
4. Select the correct module
5. From the right menu "Import into Canvas," select the course(s) you want to import into
6. Select the green button "Import into Course"
